This multi-purpose addition to the Wood County fairgrounds provides 42,500 sf of event and exhibit space and takes the place of five older barns. The fair is nearly 150 years old and is located in Bowling Green, Ohio south of Toledo. The fair board is hoping the new building will be rented out for meetings, receptions, and trade shows.

The rigid frame gabled building includes a 150' clear span providing a show arena with room to house hogs and cattle on either end. The interior of this pavilion is lined with KirbyRib II liner panel. Wainscot is used to enhance the sides and front of the building which features a below eave boxed entry canopy with suspended soffit. In addition to the livestock areas of the building, the facility also includes a finished meeting room that can accommodate at least 100 people with catering prep room, allowing the building to be used throughout the year.
