### Early Ford Foundation Event Center & V-8 Museum

#### Builder: Muhlenkamp Building Corporation

Kirby Authorized Builder, Muhlenkamp Building Corporation of Coldwater, OH, has worked with the Early Ford Foundation to complete two buildings in Auburn, IN.

In 2018, an expansion project for the existing Early Ford V-8 Foundation Museum was designed using two single slope Kirby buildings. The additional structures are attached to an existing Nucor building. It features a 56-0 Rotunda made from Aluminum Composite Metal, partially supported by the roof of the Kirby structure. It is enclosed using Kirby's A-Panel wall system, parapet walls on all exterior walls, and a membrane roof with the roof deck by Kirby.



Last year, Muhlenkamp again worked with the Foundation for the 15,000 sf Event Center, which was designed using two single slope Kirby buildings — 50' X 110' and 50' X 190'. The structure utilizes Kirby's SS360 standing seam roof system in galvalume and Kirby's A-Panel wall system in polar white to match the existing building. Additionally, curved flat panels at the entry canopy and exterior and curved glass are notable attributes of the structure.
